- Twenty-two Covenants in The Scriptures
- The main purpose of a COVENANT:
  - ♦ His desire for relationships relationship with Him and all other people.
  - ◆ The very nature of a covenant is the bond between the parties of the covenant, each saying "Everything I have is yours".

- NO covenant replaces any prior covenant!
- Each covenant builds on, reinforces previous covenants
- At a future session examine original Greek text for "NEW covenant" to be better translated as "ANEW", "RE-NEWED", or "EXPANDED".
- New in QUALITY, not new IN TIME!
- Hebrew word "KHAWDASH" in Jeremiah 31:31, and the Greek word KAINOS.
- root meaning KHAWDASH denotes a "renewal", a restoration of that which is.

- Why are Jewish Covenants still valid for Christians today?
- It is important to remember that Christians are grafted into Israel
- Romans 11:17
- 16 For if the firstfruit be holy, the lump is also holy: and if the root be holy, so are the branches.
- 17 And if some of the branches be broken off, and thou, being a wild olive tree, wert grafted in among them, and with them partakest of the root and fatness of the olive tree;
- 18 Boast not against the branches. But if thou boast, thou bearest not the root, but the root thee.

- Why are all of the twenty-two Covenants in Scripture important for believers?
- These covenants contain or establish our beliefs and strengthen us as we prepare for eternal life.
- One of His most essential characteristics is that He delights in making and keeping His promises.
- One of the most disturbing shortcomings of many modern churches is their failure to appreciate the seriousness of these covenants.

- Our God is a God who keeps Covenant!
- **He guarantees it with His Blood.**
