- The Promises to the Christians as members of the Abrahamic Covenant.
- The God of scripture made this commitment to withhold nothing beneficial from this one group:
- Abraham and his seed.

- Promises Christians have today through Christ
- The Promises were made to "Abraham and Christ"
- As man, Jesus was the seed of Abraham.
- Galatians 3:16 "Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy seed, which is Christ"
- The meaning of Galatians 3:16 can be stated therefore as: "Now to Abraham and Christ were the promises made".

- Promises Christians have today through Christ
- promise 49:
- with Isaac's seed after him for an everlasting covenant.

- Promises Christians have today through Christ
- Isaac , the first offspring (seed) of Abraham.
- Abraham, Sarah,
- Isaac, (son of FREE woman) (Gal 4:21–31)
- Ismael, (son of BOND woman)
- Jacob,
- Israel, (nation)
- Christians. (via SEED of Abraham or "membership" promises)

Promises Christians have today through Christ

- Isaac, the "child of the Promise"
- The first offspring (seed) of Abraham.
- What the first offspring (Isaac) inherited, also the later offspring inherited, like Jacob, and the whole nation of Israel.

- Promises Christians have today through Christ
- Membership Promises: 8, 30, 33, 34, 35, 37, 39, 45, 46, 49, 56, 59, and 60 in the ABRAHAMIC Covenant. (INCLUDES THE CHRISTIANS)
- The list we use is paraphrased to keep it short.
- There is a separate file with a listing of reference scriptures from the NKJV translation.

- Membership Promises: 8, 30, 33, 34, 35, 37, 39, 45, 46, 49, 56, 59, and 60 in the ABRAHAMIC Covenant.
- Genesis 12:3
- #8. In you shall all families of the earth be blessed (or bless themselves) (v.3).

- Promises Christians have today through Christ
- Membership Promises: 8, 30, 33, 34, 35, 37, 39, 45, 46, 49, 56, 59, and 60 in the ABRAHAMIC Covenant.
- Genesis 17:1-22 (#27 #55)
- #30. You will be a father of many nations (Gen17:4).
- #33. I will make nations of you (Genesis 17 v.6).
- #34. Kings shall come from you (Genesis 17 v.6).
- #35. The covenant between God, Abraham, and his seed in their generations coming after Abraham is an everlasting covenant (Genesis 17 v.7).

- #37. I will be a God to your seed after you (Gen17:7)
- #39. And I will be their (your seed's) God (Gen17:8)
- #45. Sarah will be a mother of nations (Gen17:16)
- #46. Kings of people shall be from Sarah, Gen17:16

- Promises Christians have today through Christ
- Membership Promises: 8, 30, 33, 34, 35, 37, 39, 45, 46, 49, 56, 59, and 60 in the ABRAHAMIC Covenant.
- #49. I will establish my covenant with Isaac's seed after him for an everlasting covenant (Genesis 17 v.19).

- Promises Christians have today through Christ
- Membership Promises: 8, 30, 33, 34, 35, 37, 39, 45, 46, 49, 56, 59, and 60 in the ABRAHAMIC Covenant.
- Genesis 22:16-18 #56 #60
- #56. God guaranteed the covenant with His oath, saying, "By Myself have I sworn..." (Gen 22:6).
- #59. Your seed (descendants) shall possess the gate of his enemies (Genesis 22 v.17).
- #60. In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, (Genesis 22 v.18).

- Promises Christians have today through Christ
- Membership Promises: 8, 30, 33, 34, 35, 37, 39, 45, 46, 49, 56, 59, and 60 in the ABRAHAMIC Covenant.
- Christians have at least these 13 promises today

- Promises Christians have today through Christ
- "ACCORDING TO" = KATA (+ Isaac)
- Abraham and Sarah were too old to bear children. Any hope they had for children rested squarely upon supernatural help from God.
- Under these impossible conditions, God gave Promise 15 to Abraham. "He that shall come forth out of thine own loins shall be thine heir."
- This promise was realized in the birth of Isaac in Promise 47, "Sarah's son shall be named Isaac." As such, Isaac was a "child of promise." Specifically, he was the "child of Promise 15"

- Promises Christians have today through Christ
- "ACCORDING TO" = KATA (+ Isaac)
- Galations 4:28 "Now we, brethren, as Isaac was, are the children of promise". "As Isaac was" is the translation of KATA plus Isaac. KATA, in this context, means "according to."
- To restate the passage literally then, Christians are included in the Abrahamic Seed Group "according to" the way in which Isaac himself was included.
- Hence the term: "Children of The Promise"

- Promises Christians have today through Christ
- Moses and Peter
- Moses described the Abrahamic Seed Group as chosen, holy, royal, and peculiar. The following Scriptures contain his description of this group:
- 1. "...ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people:..ye shall be unto me a kingdom of priests, and an holy nation..." (Exodus 19:5-6).

- Promises Christians have today through Christ
- Moses and Peter
- 2. "For thou art an holy people unto the Lord thy God; the Lord thy God hath chosen thee to be a special people unto himself, above all nations that are upon the earth" (Deut. 14:2).
- 3. "And the Lord hath avouched thee this day to be his peculiar people...and to make thee high above all nations...that thou mayest be an holy people unto the Lord thy God, as he hath spoken" (Deut. 26:18-19).

- Promises Christians have today through Christ
- Moses and Peter
- Centuries later, the Apostle Peter used the same terminology to describe the same group of people, the Abrahamic Seed Group during the Christian era or Church age. He said, "...ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people,..." (1 Peter 2:9).

- Promises Christians have today through Christ
- Moses and Peter
- Although separated by centuries, the Abrahamic Seed Group are the same no matter the time in which they live.
- As such, they are described with the same terminology.

- Promises Christians have today through Christ
- Moses and Peter
- Furthermore, Peter said to this same Abrahamic Seed Group, now composed of Christians, that they were "called unto blessing." He further said the purpose of this call unto blessing is that they should inherit "blessing".
- Specifically, he said, "Not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing: but contrariwise blessing; knowing that ye are thereunto called, that you should inherit 'a blessing' " (1 Peter 3:9).

- Promises Christians have today through Christ
- Summary 1
- We have seen that the Abrahamic Covenant is still in force during the Church age.
- Christians compose the Abrahamic Seed Group during the Church age.
- the Abrahamic Seed Group is still called holy, chosen, royal, and peculiar, during the Church age. Rev 1:6 And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his

Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

- Promises Christians have today through Christ
- Summary 2
- Peter says that the same Seed Group during the Church age is to inherit the same EULOGIA, and EULOGIA still means "the beneficial enduement of God's power to produce well-being in every area of their lives," including, as we have seen, health and wealth.

- Promises Christians have today through Christ
- (2 Cor 1:20) For all the promises of God in him are yea, and in Him Amen, unto the glory of God by us.
- All the Promises we as Christians have "in Him Amen", (Christ).
- The Promises were purchased at high cost !!
- He, laying down His life: obedience unto death.

Followed by collecting the Tithe

- Promises Christians have today through Christ
- What does this mean for us Christians?
- Let's look at John 3:16 and "the other" John 3:16 (1 John 3:16).
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- 1 John 3:16 Hereby perceive we the love of God, because He laid down his life for us: and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren.
- The "Vertical relationship", asks for a "Horizontal relationship" between the brothers and sisters in Christ.

- Promises Christians have today through Christ
- JOHN 6:53-58 "COVENANT" COMMUNION TEXT
- Mat 26:26-28 FAMILIAR COMMUNION TEXT

- **4. THE FEAST** (STEP 4 OF THE BLOOD COVENANT RITUAL)
- This involved two things:
 - the flesh of the sacrificial animal was eaten.
 - Second, the blood of the animal was drunk by both parties.
- They drank it in one of three ways:
 - directly,
 - mixed in juice or wine,
 - or substituting juice or wine with no blood in it at all.
 - Note: In The Scriptures the Israelites were NEVER allowed to drink blood since it represents LIFE itself. See presentation T07, slides 7, 14.

- 4. THE FEAST (STEP 4 OF THE BLOOD COVENANT RITUAL)
- John 6:53 Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, ye have no life in you. 54 Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day. 55 For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed. 56 He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him. 57 As the living Father hath sent me, and I live by the Father: so he that eateth me, even he shall live by me. 58 This is that bread which came down from **heaven:** not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever.

- 4. THE FEAST (STEP 4 OF THE BLOOD COVENANT RITUAL)
- Mat 26:26-27
- And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed it, and brake it, and gave it to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body. 27 And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, Drink ye all of it;
- See also Mark 14:22, 23, and 1Cor 11:24, 25
- this cup is the new testament in my blood
- new in quality, newly expanded, the expanded original.
- **a contract**, a devisory *will*, **covenant**, testament.
